Role	Description
Mollie Ralston	Female 20's: the young owner of Monkswell Manor Guesthouse. She is warm, kind but can come across as a bit naive. Though intelligent, she is at times unsure of herself, but can be rather assertive when the situation calls for it. She is mostly a people pleaser and has a generally positive outlook.
Giles Ralston	Male 20's: Mollie's husband, rather more cynical in his world-view. The two make a good team as his calmness tends to balance out her more frantic nature. He is wary of strangers, quick to judge and generally untrusting. He loves his wife and easily moved to jealousy by his protective nature.
Christopher Wren	Male 20's: a very peculiar young man. He has a curious and inquisitive nature, bordering on intrusive. He seems to lack certain social graces and offends many of the guests of Monkswell Manor. He is also endearing, charming in a quirky way, and can give the appearance of being more than a little unhinged.
Mrs. Boyle	Female 60's/70's: a crotchety old lady, who seems quite impossible to please. Quick to criticize, she does not hesitate in expressing her dissatisfaction. She is stubborn, arrogant and has an air of superiority. She has the classic British "stiff upper lip" and is very much concerned with propriety.
Major Metcalf	Male 50's/60's: a retired army major. He is a proper gentleman, but also has dry sense of humour. He is quiet and pensive, as he takes it all in.
Miss Casewell	Female late 20's/30's: a very reserved and private person. Often brooding, she has a sharp wit and is a keen observer. She seems to care very little about the opinions of others and can come across as quite brash. She is not overly concerned with propriety.
Mr. Paravicini	Male any age: Mr. Paravicini is a mystery. Speaking with an affected Italian accent, he arrives at the guesthouse unexpectedly in the midst of a snow storm. Little is known about him or his past and he revels in this air of mystery and intrigue. Mischievous, he seems to delight in creating unrest in the other guests and enjoys the thrill of the situation more than is proper.
Detective Sergeant Trotter	male 20's: seems very young, but quite capable as a detective. He appears eager and energetic and has commanding presence. He takes his job seriously and is very methodical in his investigation.
